

MFA Leadership Program Application (2026–2027)

Purpose of the Leadership Program

As MFA continues to grow, this Leadership Program provides a structured and fair process for selecting student leaders. It allows all interested students, including current Board Members, to demonstrate their involvement, commitment, and leadership potential.

Program Timeline

- Application Deadline: March 30
- Program Period: April – June
- Leadership Team Announcement: May 30
- Leadership Term Begins: Summer 2026

All applications must be submitted before the program begins in April. Late applications may not be considered.

Eligibility

Students are expected to meet the following to be considered for a Board Member position:

- Have completed at least 40 hours of MFA service
- Maintain consistent participation in MFA activities
- Attend Board Meetings regularly (no more than 3 absences, including excused)

For the current selection cycle, students who have not yet reached 40 hours may still apply, but must complete the required hours by May 30 to be considered.

Consistent participation during this period will also be taken into consideration.

About MFA (Music For All)

Music For All (MFA) is a student-led organization focused on serving the community through music.

Our main activities include:

- Community performances (hospitals, nursing homes, schools, public venues)
- Benefit and community concerts
- Music collaboration and accompaniment
- Chamber ensemble programs
- Junior coaching and mentorship
- Student lessons and outreach

Students are involved not only as performers, but also in planning, organizing, and leading these activities.
